## Travione Lockhart



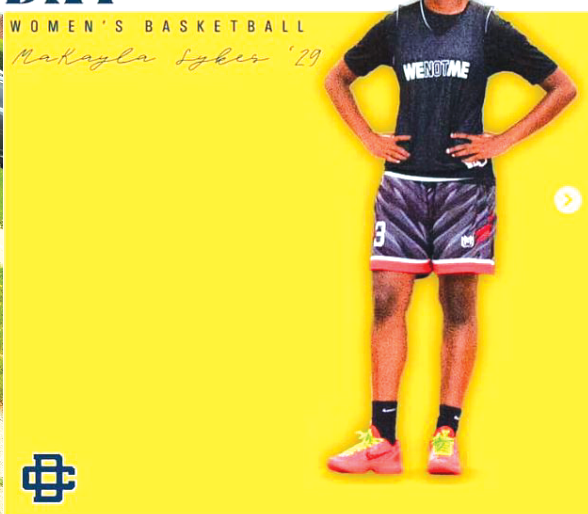
Travione Lockhart is known for his stylish drip and entrepreneurial spirit. He is a graduate of Old Redford Academy and played on the varsity football team.
